
### **Bar/Bat Mitzvah: Your birthday matters!**

During the week you were born, a section of Torah was being read in synagogues all over the world. Every letter of Scripture is relevant for all, but there's something special about knowing your Torah portion – the Words of Life that were being spoken when Adonai called you from your mother's womb.

So it is a beautiful tradition that girls at 12 years and boys at 13 years make their bar or bat mitzvah during the week that their Torah portion is read. The words Bar or Bat Mitzvah mean Son or Daughter of the Commandment, respectively; a declaration that you are a son or daughter of the Covenant. There is no age restriction to such a declaration.
